
What is PyroAg **Wood Vinegar** and how is it made?

PyroAg Wood Vinegar, is a natural biostimulant helping improve soil health and reducing chemical input for a more sustainable farming future.

PyroAg Wood Vinegar, also known as Pyroligneous Acid, is a natural amber coloured liquid that smells like smoke. It is used to improve soil biology, promote the growth of plants and reduce chemical dependency. It helps to build the plants natural resistance to environmental stressors and improves uptake of other substances you are applying to your crops or trees.

PyroAg Wood Vinegar is made in a controlled biochar manufacturing process, by heating organic biomass in an oxygen reduced environment, this leads to the materials decomposition. The smoke gases are cooled and condensed which become liquids: it then undergoes further proprietary refining processes we developed to ensure the highest quality product.

What remains is PyroAg Wood Vinegar, a high quality, dense liquid substance made up of natural Organic Acids.

Backed by science

PyroAg invests in science to better understand the benefits PyroAg Wood Vinegar can bring to growers and to optimise the applications. We are currently carrying out research with The University of Newcastle to better understand the methods of improved crop yields, and starting a trial with Sydney University to measure possible methane reduction in pasture grazing.

Our previous research carried out by The University of Newcastle published a study Effect of Pyroligneous Acid on the Microbial Community Composition and Plant Growth-Promoting Bacteria (PGPB) in Soils to uncover the benefits associated with wood vinegar.

This study demonstrated PyroAg Wood Vinegar's potential in improving the soil biological health as quoted by Professor Megh Mallavarapu, The University of Newcastle.

"Such a high abundance of the beneficial PGPB at lower PA concentrations could positively relate to better soil quality, indicating enhanced plant growth and vield"

"In contrast, higher concentrations of PA promoted the abundance of spore-forming bacterial genera such as Bacillus, which is responsible for defensive action such as reducing the pathogenic bacteria and pest control."

"Overall, this study demonstrates PA's potential for improving soil biological health by enhancing the beneficial plant growth-promoting bacteria."

The results of the study backed our farmers' in field observations and results, and clearly showed that PyroAg Wood Vinegar helps to improve soil quality, plant growth and yield.
